

UNAFAS supporting basic education in primary schools

Fifteen thousand colourful English language reading books were presented to school managers in August.

The PCC and CBC Education secretaries and NW regional delegations for basic and secondary education received the books from UNAFAS, and passed them on, amongst much appreciation, to those managing schools on the ground.

The managers are together responsible for more than 150 primary schools, many in poor rural areas, where purchasing books is beyond the means of most parents. The books will reach class rooms early in the first term of 2009/10 school year: from Donga-Mantung, to Mbengwi, Kumba and Limbe areas.
